

#### ABOUT C-ARTS

Center for Autism Rehabilitation and Training, Sindh (C-ARTS) was established in 2018 under Section 42 of the Companies Act, 2017 as a **NOT FOR PROFIT** Company. The Company owned by the Government of Sindh, aims to provide professional rehabilitation facilities to Autistic children in Sindh Province, train professionals in rehabilitation methods in Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and work for awareness and increasing social empathy on ASD.

The Center was inaugurated by the Chief Minister Sindh, Syed Murad Ali Shah on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2018. The purpose-built building with international standards can accommodate 300 children and is the biggest Autism Center of South Asia.

All services to Autistic children are provided free of cost as per the vision of the Government of Sindh.

#### VISION & MISSION

#### VISION

To be recognized as an effective provider of quality rehabilitation services and educational opportunities for children and adolescent with Autism Spectrum Disorder in Sindh Province.

#### MISSION

To provide an integrated academic and therapeutic program to each individual with Autism and other neuro developmental disorders so that they realize their fullest potential and to expand our impact through education, innovative research and public policy.

### OBJECTIVES

- To set up an Autism Rehabilitation & Training Center as per international standards.
- To cater for the needs of less privileged with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) children who cannot afford private services available in the market.
- To work as a training Center to train and develop experts in different areas catering to ASD rehabilitation, for the public as well as the private sector.
- To work as a Center for increasing awareness about the disorder, and about Autistic Children/Persons and sensitize the society to accept them in the mainstream.
- To help develop service delivery standards for ASD rehabilitation to be used by the Government to ensure delivery of optimum services by the private sector to the public.
- To establish Centers of excellence all over the Sindh province for rehabilitation of children and persons with autism, and other neuro/ brain related conditions, training of experts in these fields, and raising awareness and advocacy on these issues in the society.
- To upgrade the Center as a center of excellence for:
  - I. Research, training, diagnosis, rehabilitation, education and welfare for all neuro and brain related disabled people.
  - II. Developing practices and service standards for guiding and regulating all institutions, centers and schools in these fields.
  - III. Organizing outreach programs to incorporate society, parents and guardians of intellectual disabled people through awareness training and advocacy.

#### CEO MESSAGE

According to some estimates there may be 350,000 children with autism in Pakistan. At C-ARTS, these would be 350,000 stories of dreams and development. Each day at our center is a magical story in itself. We strive to provide professional rehabilitation facilities to the autistic children in the province of Sindh, train professionals in rehabilitation methods in ASD, and work for its awareness and increasing social empathy. With our multidisciplinary program model, the mission of the Center is to provide an integrated academic and therapeutic program to each individual with autism and other developmental disorders that they realize their fullest potential and to expand our impact through education, innovative research and public policy. Our logo, with pieces of a puzzle and a home inside a blue circle, depicts the puzzle pieces as primary symbols of autism, which date back to 1963, created by the National Autistic Society in London that believed autistics suffered from a puzzling condition. However, we have decided to give it a new meaning; to us, it is more of a sign of unity, ensconced in a blue circle that represents hope and a home for children and other people with ASD - puzzle pieces of therapies coming together to solve a single maze. This is a remarkable reflection of the work our teachers and our students do every day to achieve a unified goal for growth and rehabilitation. Autism doesn't come with an instruction guide; it comes with a family who will never give up. The world needs these families to work together. At C-ARTS, we are that family for these brilliant youngsters. We focus on what these children can do, not on what they cannot do. We take an interest in their interests. We look at autism with our hearts; because our eyes might miss something. We learn from them a thing or two, because these kids don't lie, they don't judge, they are miles away from the vice of this world. They are, indeed, the epitome of uniqueness, and we want to be the people helping them on their way to this realization.



### OPERATIONS UPDATE

#### Student Enrollment

Our Thousand Mile Journey begins in April 2019 with the inauguration of services by Mr. Bilawal Bhutto Zardari, since then we are adding new milestones to our services every day and by the grace of Almighty ALLAH today we are providing services to more than 150 students with Autism.

Each of the enrolled student at C-ARTS has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) which is developed after his/her Psychological Assessment Report. Based on this report the student is provided one to one therapy, group sessions, and schooling programs.

#### **Consultant Clinics**

As per the commitment to become the center of excellence, C-ARTS started one of its kind free consultant clinics for children with special needs. Clinics were inaugurated by Chief Minister Sindh, Syed Murad Ali Shah on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

The multidisciplinary team of Doctors comprises of Pediatric Neurologist, Pediatric Psychiatrist and Physiatrist (Rehabilitation Medicine Consultant). To serve the larger community and create more impact, the management of the C-ARTS has expanded the scope of these clinics to other disabilities as well.


On monthly basis, 120 children with disabilities are availing these free of cost services from throughout the province.


